



About Knowledge City & Mr. Md. Abdur Rob

On 6th day of April 1962, a child took birth in a respectable family of Rajarhat village, P.S. Usthi, Dist South 24 Parganas and was named as Md. Abdur Rob by his parent. Abdur Rob was the second child of Mr. Yakub Ali and Mrs. Marjina Begum who too had two other children also..

Mr. Yakub Ali was a known freedom fighter and he had been the primary associates of famous leader and social worker Mr. Pravash Roy, Jotish Roy, Kansari Halder, Charu Chandra Bhandari and Mr. Prafulla Sen. Mr. Yakub Ali was jailed before Independence but he left politics after India become Independent.

A man driven by his desire to serve the mankind found his way to a little known place Rajarhat and in order to upliftment of the lowest rungs of the society especially for the cause of Education he established Rajarhat High Madrasa, Rajarhat Hayatnagar pre-primary School and another six Education center in the locality. Apart from that he also helped in establishing number of small Education segments, Mandir, Masjid, Madrasa and Library etc. for his extreme desire to serve the downtrodden, the orphans and the destitutes.

Md. Abdur Rob at first educated himself in the Hayatnagar Primary School; an Institution established by his father. Subsequently he passed Secondary School Certificate from Rajarhat Madrasha which again an Institution established by his father. He then passed Higher Secondary Examination from Diamond Harbour College and graduated himself from Vivekananda College. He obtained Masters Degree in Bengali and History from Rabindra Bharati University. He got B.Ed degree and obtained Doctorate during the year 2019.

Md Abdur Rob, basically a teacher by profession, had served Rani Rashmoni High School at Kolkata. While in service he took active part in public speaking cum movement in order to eradicate lots of unsocial activities, he found himself fighting all kind of adversities against certain promoters in Diamond Harbour Road area even at the stake of his life. In all his good attempts and activities he got helped reasonably from renowned social activists like Medha Patkar, Mahasweta Devi and others (Resort Birodhi Movement).

The selfless and untiring spirit that he is, Md Abdur Rob has also worked in his father's brick kilns during his leisure. Md Abdur Rob and his family had lot of ancestral cultivatable land surrounded by weed lands. He therefore thought and planned to establish a small township in that area with greenary, water bodies and natural beauty. He also planned public amenities like housing, schools, college, hospital etc. in the vicinity. He gave the area a name as 'KNOWLEDGE CITY' a clean city, a green city. The impact of his humanitarian work can now be seen in the types of Institutions that he has already established which can now be revered as an undiluted example of his service towards mankind and the society.

Md. Abdur Rob strongly believes that education is the core for social upliftment of the under priviledged. Development and progress would then be boosted in the society once the education is spreaded in segments. The idea behind this theme was to give the Knowledge City a panaroma alike Rabindranath Tagore's Shantiniketan which seemed to be little inconclusive. Knowledge City, comparatively has been planned more or less realistic and creative which idea has provoked the planner to organise systematic housing, schooling (english and bengali medium), medical college, B.Ed college, hospital with medical facilities, law college, pharmacy college and nursing college etc. Such idea immediately may sound little unrealistic but in the long run, he strongly believes that Knowledge City would be a passion for love to the population yet to come. Moreso when all such activities have started in full swing on ground.

Yet other steps which Mr. M A Rob has adopted are to promote kinds of Festivals alike Shantiniketan i.e 'Basanto Utsav' in open auditorium, 'Poush Mela', Harvesting and Tree planting, organising varieties of cultural program by indoor and outdoor artists. He also took keen interest to look after their comforts and arrange all hospitality including fooding, lodging and travelling etc. immaterial of any cast, creed and religion which definitely has proved Abdur Rob a great citizen of mankind with exemplary 'Service before Self.'

Newly established college in the name of Momtaz Begum Pharmacy College at Knowledge City, Hayatnagar Rajarhat, near Amtala, South 24 Parganas. The College offers D. Pharma Course (2 Years Diploma) after H.S. (12th Std.).





Eligibility Criteria

Admission to the 2 years D. Pharm Course

A candidate passing the H.S. (10+2) examination (with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary education (with minimum 50% aggregate marks in best fur subjects for general category and 45% marks for SC, ST, OBC, PWD candidates) or any other equivalent examination of a recognized board or council.

Candidates should have qualified CET conducted by MAKAUT on the admission year.

Candidates passing 10+2 examination or equivalent examination in vocational stream are not eligible for admission in D. Pharma as Stated by the Pharmacy Council of India.

Candidate shall complete the age of 17 Years on or before 31st December of the year.

Admission Requirement

Admission must be taken by submitting the following documents:-

- Original Statement of marks with certified copy
- Original Caste Certificate by student intending to avail benefits.
- Passing certificate and certified copy of document indicating the date of birth.
- Foreign student seeking admission should produce their visa at the time of admission.
- Foreign student holding tourist visas or entry visas will not considered.
- Photocopy of AADHAR CARD (SelfAttested)
- Photocopy of Voter ID Card (Self Attested)

Rules

General Rules Regarding Discipline

- 1. Students shall abide by any general or special rules made by the college authorities in regard to the conduct of the students both in and outside the college and the decision of the college authorities shall be final, Parents and Guardians are also presumed to have agreed to these rules when their wards join the college.
- 2. Students should in their own interest read the college notices, including notices containing rules placed on the Notice Boards from time to time. It Shall be the duty of each student to scan all the notices daily.
- Students are required to dress decently. Dress code prescribe by College is mandatory.

The Following shall be deemed as acts of indiscipline:

- 1. Resorting to ragging, a student involved in any such act is liable to be expelled from the college and in addition may undergo imprisonment and fine.
- Smoking, consumption of alcoholic drinks, intoxicants and narcotic drugs.
- 3. An act which cause destruction or defacing of the property of the college or organizing raids and breaking into the premises of college.
- 4. An act which interferes with the personal liberty of another person or subject another to indignity, or involves physical violence or use of abusive language.
- 5. An act which causes interference of outside person or bodies or agencies in the functioning of the college.
- 6. Dissemination & assertion of any false statement or tempering of certificates and records, whether with a view to seeking admission in a college or securing any benefit whatsever.
- 7. Collection of funds for any program, picnic, excursion, project or activity without prior written permission of the appropriate authority
- 8. A act which disrupts the smooth running of the college or environment conducive to the pursuit of knowledge or harmonious relationship between different group of students.
- 9. An act which trends to lower in the public estimate the image of the college or their officers.
- 10. An act of unruly and disorderly behavior at any competitions, sports, cultural activities or other social or educational programs organized by the college.
- 11. Breach of ordinances and rules relating to attendance at lecture tutorials, tests terminal or preliminary examinations and progress to the satisfaction of the principal.
- 12. Any act of insubordination or rude behavior or use of inappropriate language towards the principal or any professor of the college or non-teaching staff.
- 14. Generally, any other act of indiscipline which, in the opinion of the principal of college is unbecoming of a student.

Procedure for imposing punitive action:

- Any student of the college who has committed one or more of the acts of indiscipline mentioned above shall be subject to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Principal, who may refer the matter to any professor or a committee of enquiry appointed for the purpose.
- 2. Every student who has been alleged to have committed an act or acts of indiscipline shall be given an opportunity to be heard before any disciplinary action is taken against him/her.
